Minutes of the 264th meeting of the Standing Linkage Committee (Short Term) for cement plants held in New Delhi on 19th December, 2008

List of participants is at Annexure-I.

2. Additional Secretary (LA) welcomed Special Secretary (Coal), the Chairman of SLC (ST) and other participants and initiated discussions. He informed that the meeting has been convened to decide coal allocations for the fourth quarter of 2008-09 i.e. January-March, 2009 in respect of cement sector. He also informed that with signing of FSAs the role of SLC(ST) is now somewhat redundant hence it would be the last SLC(ST) in its present form.

3. SS (Coal) and Chairman of SLC (ST) once again reiterated the need for placing all relevant information relating to FSAs, source of supply, quantity of supply, details of the consumer etc. in public domain.

4. The representative of Railways informed that Railways are geared up for movement of coal to cement sector as per proposed linkages for last quarter and cement companies may avail of enhanced evacuation capacity including facilities for loading from Good shed, private sidings etc.

5. The representative of CMA gave an overview of the cement industry's performance during current financial year. He informed that during the period April-November, 2008, the cement industry achieved a production of 115.38 million tonnes as against the production of 108.20 million tonnes during the corresponding period last year, achieving a growth rate of about 6.6%. For the year 2008-09, a production target of 191.50 million tonnes has been fixed. It was informed that during the period April-October, 2008, the coal receipt against linkage was 7.48 million tonnes as against 8.87 million tonnes, during the corresponding period of last year. While materialization of CIL was 71% for the period April-September, 2008, the materialization of supplies from CIL improved to 87% in October and to 90% in November, 2008. During April-October, 2008, the fuel consumption by cement plants was 15.88 million tonnes as against 15.58 million tonnes during the corresponding period of last year. In addition to the coal received against linkage, the cement industry also procured imported coal, pet coke, lignite and indigenous coal from open market for meeting the overall demand of kilns and Captive Power Plants.

6. The representative of CMA raised the following issues for consideration of the Committee:-

(a) need for sanction of new long term coal linkages for proposed new capacities and linkages for enhanced capacities that have already come up;

(b) CPPs of cement industry are presently being accorded lower priority with reference to movement of coal as compared to power utilities, which is resulting in lesser movement of coal and therefore, movement of coal to cement CPPs be given same priority as given to power utilities.

(b) some of the cement companies who were granted long term coal linkage/LOA have approached the concerned coal companies for conclusion of Fuel Supply Agreements (FSAs) by following LOA route but FSAs are yet to be concluded.

7. Replying to the observations of representative of CMA, CIL representative informed that supplies to cement plants have now improved and hoped that during the last quarter, coal companies would be able to maintain this trend. As regards conclusion of FSAs, he informed that due to delay in decision on detailed procedure to be followed in such cases, FSAs were not concluded earlier and CIL has now advised coal companies in this regard and therefore concerned coal companies can be approached for signing FSA.

8. In respect of granting same priority for cement CPPs as power utilities, it was noted by the Committee that this issue had been examined in the past and Railways have already conveyed their views.

9. After detailed discussions, linkages for fourth quarter of 2008-09 i.e. January-March, 2009 were approved as per **Annexure-II**.
